Reading:

ALL students reading At or Above their expected levels: 90%

On the back of this report is a slide taken from Charlotte Wilkinson's (Maths Consultant) presentation earlier this year. It shows that the National Standards in relation to where we used to expect students to achieve - the National Norms. This is for Maths, but it is the same for reading and writing. All the results above are against the National Standards. We now make an overall teacher judgement as to where each child is, taking into consideration their application of the skills they have, across the curriculum.
